Patients' Rights and Responsibilities

As a patient here I have the right to:

- 1. information regarding my diagnosis and treatment options and informed consent to the extent provided by law.
- 2. prompt and appropriate treatment.
- 3. considerate and respectful care.
- 4. discuss my concerns with my treating person.
- 5. Confidentiality of records and communications to the extent provided by law.
- 6. privacy when receiving care.
- prompt and adequate answers to reasonable requests and needs for treatment or service.
- 8. inspect my record, and receive a copy of my record, as prescribed by law.
- refuse to serve as a research subject, or refuse to accept any treatment or examination when the primary purpose is educational or informational rather than therapeutic.
- 10. request and receive a copy of an itemized statement of my treatment and charges.

As a patient I'understand I have the responsibility to:

- provide, to the best of my knowledge, accurate and complete information about current medical complaints, past illnesses, hospitalizations, medicines and other issues relevant to my care, and changes to these.
- 2. inform my provider promptly if I do not understand information relating to my care and treatment or I receive instructions that I cannot comply with.
- 3. keep appointments, or telephone when I cannot keep a scheduled appointment.
- 4. provide information regarding changes in my medical insurance.
- 5. accept responsibility for my actions, if I refuse treatment or do not follow my provider's instructions.
- 6. be considerate of other patients and property
- 7. behave reasonably and appropriately in the office setting.
- 8. fulfill my financial responsibilities
